

COMMUNITY PLANTING

We have organised planting events throughout the park. These have included, the Eastern Road Entrance, Wood and the shade garden. We have joined forces on two occasions with the bowls club, when we were awarded ornamental bulbs from the Big Bulb Plant.

More recently we have received bulbs from the MPGA which we planted in the shade garden, along with plants donated from the Chelsea flower show.

We have planted over 1500 hedge plants and tree saplings, the orchard and other fruit and nut trees throughout the park. We established the orchard with Transition Brockley and are working to improve the biodiversity of the park. To commemorate 100 years since WWI, for the duration of the war, we have sown a memorial meadow with poppy and cornflower seeds.
