**Day:** **SUNDAY 7<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY, 2016**

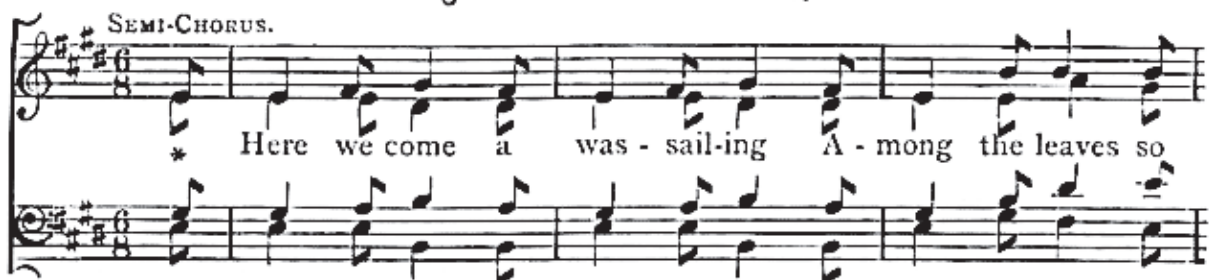
**Time:** **4.00pm** (but if you want to help with orchard maintenance you can come along at **2pm**)
